The construction permit as issued contained two special operating conditions or restrictions. Both of these special conditions or restrictions pertain to human exposure to radiofrequency radiation at the site.

The first of the two special conditions pertains to the placement of warning signs describing the nature of the hazard. There are signs posted throughout the site which describe the potential for exposure. In addition, signs are installed at the base of the tower. Finally, the site has specific policies in place that require coordination during work periods. Such coordination also requires facilities to notify management when auxiliary facilities are not operational. A monitoring system is also installed which at a glance depicts the operational condition of each facility at the site.

The second special condition requires that the applicant coordinate with other users of the site to ensure that workers are not exposed to levels of radio frequency radiation which may exceed the applicable safety standards. Coordination policies are in effect at the site requiring such actions to take place during periods of work. Coordination efforts include, but are not limited to, a reduction in power or cessation of operation of the facility. Since this facility is an auxiliary for KSIV-FM, it typically will not be active and would normally only be used during times of maintenance to the main antenna or failure.
