

Statement Regarding Contingent Applications

Cox Radio, Inc. ("Cox"), licensee of WBTS(FM), Doraville, Georgia, and Williams Communications, Inc. ("Williams"), licensee of WHMA-FM, Hobson City, Alabama, pursuant to Section 73.3517(e) of the FCC's Rules, are filing on a contingent basis on the date hereof applications for modifications of their respective facilities, described as follows:

1. WBTS(FM). Cox's amendment to its pending application for WBTS(FM) (FCC File No. BPH-20060501AOE) proposes for WBTS(FM) to retain its current class and operate on Channel 238C1.

2. WHMA-FM. In coordination with Cox's WBTS(FM) amendment, Williams proposes to change WHMA-FM's community of license to Alexandria, Alabama and to change to Channel 237A.

The parties request that these applications be processed and acted upon together and that neither of them be granted or acted upon in the absence of the other.

Attached to this application is the Contingent Applications Agreement made and entered into on October 5, 2007, by and among Cox Radio, Inc. and Williams Communications, Inc.
