This letter refers to: the above-captioned application filed by CBI; our January 23, 2009, letter granting additional time to amend until April 15, 2009; the April 15, 2009, request for an additional 90 days to amend; and the May 6, 2009, letter filed by CBI in response to the April 20, 2009, letter filed by Gold Coast Broadcasting, Inc. (GCB), in which GCB objected to CBI's request for additional time to amend.

Accordingly, CBI is hereby granted an additional 180 days from the date of this letter in which to file a fully complete electronic amendment bringing the application into substantial compliance with the Commission's rules.
