


CONSENT TO INTERFERENCE

Television Station WESH, Daytona Beach, Florida, licensed to Orlando Hearst-Argyle Television, Inc. ("Hearst"), plans to seek authorization from the FCC for a low power digital replacement translator construction permit for operation on Channel 18 in Orange City, Florida.

Hearst's proposed operation on Channel 18 is predicted to cause 2.5% new interference to Television Station WMOR-TV, RF Channel 19, Lakeland, Florida. WMOR-TV is licensed to WMOR-TV Company and, together with Hearst, are commonly owned and controlled by The Hearst Corporation. WMOR-TV finds that the predicted new interference is de minimis.

Accordingly, effective on the date hereof, the undersigned, a duly authorized representative of WMOR-TV Company and Television Station WMOR-TV, hereby acknowledges the foregoing and agrees to accept the predicted interference from WESH's proposed low power digital replacement translator operation on Channel 18.
