

WAIVER REQUEST AND STATEMENT OF QUALIFICATIONS

The licensee of KHFG-LP is KHFG-LP, Inc., a non-profit corporation organized and in good standing under the laws of Montana. The corporation is recognized as a charitable organization under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

KHFG-LP, Inc. became the licensee of the station on November 6, 2006 pursuant to BALL-20060313ACC, an assignment which was granted after the original licensee was unable to sustain station operations. The transfer of control to an entirely new board of directors proposed in this application is similarly intended to preserve the station, which was in danger of failing under the management of the November 2006 board of directors.

The new board members of KHFG-LP, Inc. are qualified to control the station under the Commission's interim Section 73.865 waiver standard announced in MM Docket 99-25. All three new board members reside within 10 miles of the station's authorized transmitter site. No consideration is changing hands in connection with the proposed transfer of control. None of the three new board members has any other broadcast interests. Moreover, as stated above, the appointment of a new management group to the board of the licensee will ensure the survival and development of the station.

The statement of educational purpose as presented in BALL-20060313AAC is being modified to read as follow:

KHFG-LP, Inc.'s purpose and mission is to reach out to persons in need of spiritual and material assistance and help them in the context of Christian fellowship and teaching. To this end, the LPFM station will provide adult education programs targeting shut-ins, persons in legal trouble, the mentally ill, alcoholics and drug abusers, people in the hospital, those with marital difficulties, and persons in serious debt. Additionally, the station will broadcast educational programs addressing issues facing youth and children in the community. Such programs will focus on issues such as drug abuse and teen pregnancy. Youth leaders will be invited to participate in on-the-air panel programs dealing with these issues as well as recreation, school and religious topics. The station also will broadcast youth-oriented news and local high school sports information and will provide school event announcements and snow notifications.
