**Character Issues**

In KQED, Inc., 5 FCC Rcd 1784 (1990), recon. den., 6 FCC Rcd 625 (1991), the Commission denied KQED, Inc.'s application for renewal of license of KQEC-TV, San Francisco, based on misrepresentations made to the Commission in connection with that station. In the same case, the Commission found that the KQEC-TV conduct did not impair KQED, Inc.'s qualifications to hold licenses for KQED-TV and KQED-FM and the Commission renewed those licenses. Judicial review of the Commission's grant of the KQED-TV and KQED-FM renewals was denied in an unreported Order in California Broadcast Forum vs. FCC, Case No. 91-1111 (D.C. Cir.), decided Sept. 30, 1991, reh. den. Dec. 23, 1991.
