Dear Mr. Davis:

This is in reference to the request filed on July 22, 2019. CCL requests a further extension of the STA granted on September 28, 2010, to continue operating with parameters at variance to allow time to file the required FCC Form 302 application.¹ In support of the request, CCL states that it plans to take measurements and prepare the nighttime proof in the near future (due to replacement of two towers and other repairs).

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.


Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA is **HEREBY GRANTED**, and CCL

¹ WELI(AM) is licensed for operation on 960 kHz with a power of 5 kW ND day and DA night.

may continue to operate with parameters at variance and/or reduced power while maintaining nighttime monitor points within licensed limits (or ND using a maximum of 5 kW day and 1.25 kW at night). CCL must reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received, and use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **February 8, 2020**.
