

EXHIBIT 2 – Educational Program

The Alaska Peace Center was incorporated on March 23, 2005 in the State of Alaska.

The educational mission of the Alaska Peace Center is to inform the community about issues of peace, justice, public policy and sustainability.

The proposed low power FM station will enhance the Alaska Peace Center’s educational program by bringing music, interviews, book readings, drama, comedy, symposia, lectures, poetry performances and other genres to the Fairbanks audience. We will broadcast a spectrum of programming not widely available on Fairbanks stations and that will complement existing programming. We aim to educate our listeners about local, national and world history and news, science news that does not currently appear on local stations, drama, and serialized book readings.

The Alaska Peace Center will partner with the Fairbanks Open Radio Project to produce local programming and hold regular community workshops on recording, broadcasting, podcasting and citizen-powered media.

Examples of planned programs are:

“Democracy North!” – a program of local news & news from around the circumpolar North

“A People’s History of Alaska” – a program of oral historical recordings from local sources

“Music of the Circumpolar North”

“Renewable Alaska” – Cold climate energy efficiency information

Pentagon news – investigative reporting from the capital, related to Alaskan issues

“GI Safeline” – Open forum for families seeking to express feelings about the effects of military life and war.

A radio talk show on subsistence, and resource management

Broadcasts of local public lectures and events

Other Alaska-based programming (i.e., Richard Nelson’s “Encounters” – produced in Southeast Alaska)
