

**SUMMARY OF THE APPLICATION OF
THE B. STEPHEN DEMCHUK FOUNDATION
Including Mutual Exclusivity Factors**

Applicant- The B. Stephen Demchuk Foundation (Foundation) is a non profit corporation organized under the laws of the State of New York. Since its founding in 1994, the B. Stephen Demchuk Foundation has pursued educating the public regarding the history, culture, economy and politics of Ukraine and current events in Ukraine. These efforts have been integrated in the Foundation's initiatives to promote educational opportunities in the United States for individuals of Ukrainian background and others.

The Foundation's activities have centered in Glen Spey, Sullivan County, New York where the station will be located. Its programming will be devoted to establishing and presenting an educational forum that advances principles of democracy and freedom in Ukraine and educating listeners on the history and evolving transformation of Ukraine. The programs will explore Ukraine's relationship to regional and global issues and the United States' regional and global interests. Disciplines of science, economics and politics will comprise varied programs and will be targeted to segments of the listening population. The station's programming and operations shall be conducted on a non profit basis and be entirely noncommercial.

The Foundation has no current interests in any radio or broadcast operations nor has it any pending applications before the Commission other than this application.

Public Notice Requirements-The Foundation compliance with providing public notice in a newspaper of general circulation in the Glen Spey area informing the community about its proposal to operate a radio station is stated. It will make a copy of its application to the Commission available to the public in its public inspection file located in the community of license.

Application Window- The Foundation is submitting an application responding to a filing window opening on Friday, October 12, 2007 and closing on Friday, October 19, 2007 for FM reserved band (channels 201 – 220) applications for noncommercial educational ("NCE") FM new station and major change applications. *See Media Bureau Announces NCE FM New Station and Major Modification Application Filing Window for New and Certain Pending Proposals; Window to Open on October 12, 2007, DA 07-1613, Public Notice, 22 FCC Rcd 6726 (2007).*

Educational Objective- A separate attachment sets forth in detail showing the Foundation's educational objective and that the station will be used for advancing its educational programming furthering the objectives of the Commission's rules. All programming of the station will be noncommercial; there will be no advertisements and there shall be no support or opposition to a candidate for political office.

Parties to the Application- Neither the Foundation, any Member of its Board of Directors or its officers has any attribution interest in any other radio station.

Character Issues/Adverse Findings- Neither the Applicant, nor any party to this application, including any Member of its Board of Directors or its officers has had any interest in or connection with a Commission application that was or is subject of unresolved character issues.

Alien Ownership and Control- Neither the Foundation, any Member of its Board of Directors or its officers is an alien, a representative of an alien, a foreign government or a representative of a foreign government.

Anti-Drug Abuse Act Certification- Neither the Foundation nor any party to the application is subject to denial of federal benefits pursuant to the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.

Equal Employment Opportunity Program- The Foundation intends to employ less than five full-time employees in its station employment unit. No EEO program for women and minorities need to be filed.

Preliminary Factors in the Event of Mutual Exclusivity

Fair Distribution of Service- An authorization to the Foundation will provide a first or second NCE service. An exhibit is attached.

Point System Factors

Established Local Applicant- The Foundation has conducted educational programs in the area since 1994. An affidavit of L. Julian Demchuk describing these activities is attached. A letter from a local municipal official is also attached. Also attached are the corporate governance documents of the Foundation requiring its local character and demonstrating its history in the community.

Diversity of Ownership- Neither the Foundation or any party has any attributable interest in another authorized station. Attached are the corporate governance documents of the Foundation requiring that neither the Foundation, any Member of the Board of Directors or any officer have any attributable interest as defined by the Commission's rules.

Technical Parameters- An exhibit is attached showing the proposed station's area and population to be served.

Tie Breakers

Existing Authorizations- Neither the Foundation nor any party to the application has any existing authorization to operate a radio station. This is the only application it or any party has pending.

Engineering Data and Antenna and Site Information

The Foundation's consulting engineer has provided the engineering data and antenna and site information and the necessary exhibits.
