Dear Licensee:

This is in reference to the request filed March 31, 2017, on behalf of Marvin Kent Frandsen ("Frandsen"). Frandsen requests a third extension of the October 8, 2015 Special Temporary Authority (STA) for continued reduced power operation, due to overheating problems with the station's power generator. Frandsen expects a power line to be extended to the site in the next several months which will allow licensed operation to resume.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

The request for STA extension IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station KZHK may continue to operate at reduced power. Frandsen must notify the Commission when licensed operation is restored. Frandsen must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from radiofrequency exposure in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.
