Dear Counsel,

This letter is in reference to the above captioned informal objection filed by Georgia Television Company (Cox) on February 19, 2010 against the above captioned displacement application filed by Prism Broadcasting Network Inc. (Prism) seeking to change from analog channel 26 to analog channel 14. Cox argued that the application would violate the Commission's interference protection rules and cause new interference within the protected contour of WSB-TV's proposed replacement translator on digital channel 14. Prism's displacement application was subsequently dismissed on July 29, 2013. On March 24, 2015 Prism was granted a displacement application for digital channel 6.<sup>1</sup> Accordingly, we **DISMISS** Cox's Informal Objection as its arguments and concerns are now moot.
