
On behalf of Emmis Radio License, LLC (“Emmis”), licensee of FM broadcast station KPNT(FM), Collinsville, IL, and pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 5.203, we submit herewith, in triplicate, a request for a one-year experimental authorization to operate KPNT(FM) with a technology developed by Omnia Audio known as single sideband suppressed carrier (“SSBSC”) modulation of the stereo subcarrier in the multiplex baseband signal. The purpose of the experiment is to test whether multipath can be reduced through a reduction of occupied bandwidth and sideband pairs of the modulated carrier.

Emmis proposes to commence these tests immediately upon grant of experimental authority, and seeks a one-year authorization to operate with this technology twenty-four hours a day, seven days a week.

Emmis has authorized undersigned counsel to certify on its behalf that no party to the application is subject to a denial of federal benefits, including FCC benefits, pursuant to Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1998, 21 U.S.C. § 862. For the definition of a “party” for these purposes, see 47 C.F.R. § 1.2002(b).
