Dear MIC staff:

This is in reference to the request filed on September 13, 2017. MIC requests a final extension of the STA granted on August 22, 2016, to continue operating ND at night pending the filing of the required FCC Form 302 application to cover BP-20170313ABG.<sup>1</sup> In support of the request, MIC stated that additional time was needed to file the application.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and MIC may continue to operate ND during nighttime hours using the licensed daytime tower with a

<sup>1</sup> KEYS(AM) is licensed for operation on 1440 kHz with a 1 kW ND day and 1 kW DA night pattern, and BP-20170313ABG authorizes ND operation at night with 0.069 kW using the existing daytime tower.

maximum power of 0.069 kW, as authorized by the construction permit to adequately protect all other stations (with no change to the licensed 1 kW daytime operation). MIC must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR §1.1310.

This authority expires on **April 17, 2018**.
