TECHNICAL STATEMENT

1. This technical statement and attached exhibits were prepared on behalf of Encore Broadcasting of San Angelo I Limited Partnership (“Encore”), licensee of station KKCN, Channel 276C1, Ballinger, Texas. Encore is filing an application to correct the geographic coordinates and other technical data to update the license for the KKCN facility. Encore is also the licensee of stations KGKL, 960 kHz, KGKL-FM, Channel 248C1, and KELI, Channel 254C0, San Angelo, Texas and KNRX, Channel 243C2, Sterling City, Texas.¹ KKCN and KNRX are considered “home” to the San Angelo, Texas market, but are licensed to communities in a non-metro county. KGKL, KGKL-FM and KELI are all licensed to communities within metro counties in the San Angelo, Texas Arbitron Market (Market #283). As a result, a hybrid ownership analysis was conducted. The review will verify compliance of common ownership of metro stations in the same market under the Arbitron/BIA rated market rules, as well as a revised contour overlap study involving the non-metro stations.

ARBITRON/BIA MARKET REVIEW

2. As shown on Exhibit #1, there are eighteen AM and FM (commercial and non-commercial) stations listed in the San Angelo Arbitron Market. Encore would be in control of

four FM stations and one AM station in the market. The number of stations indicated falls in the fifteen to twenty-nine stations tier of §73.3555(a)(1)(iii) of the Commission's rules. At this level, common ownership or control of up to six stations, with no more than four in the same service, is permissible. Therefore, control of KGKL, KGKL-FM, KELI, KNRX and KKCEN in the San Angelo, Texas market is believed to be in compliance with the Commission's radio ownership rules for rated markets.

REVISED CONTOUR OVERLAP ANALYSIS

3. Since KNRX and KKCEN are non-metro stations, a study has been conducted to verify that the proposed ownership of these facilities, in conjunction with those in the nearby San Angelo, Texas Arbitron market (KGKL, KGKL-FM and KELI) is also in compliance with the Commission's multiple ownership rules. The city grade contours of these five stations are shown on Exhibit #2. As noted, the locations of the city grade contours of the stations create two distinct radio markets requiring review. Market #1 consists of AM station KGKL and FM stations KGKL-FM, KELI and KNRX.² Market #2 consists of AM station KGKL and FM stations KGKL-FM, KELI and KKCEN.

4. Since the contour of AM station KGKL is a subject station in each Market, its contour will be used to determine the number of other stations in each market to which the subject stations in that market will be added. No stations with transmitters located more than 92.0

kilometers from the boundary of the common overlap of subject stations will be considered. Further, no other facility controlled by Encore will be considered as a market contributor, unless it is a subject station in the radio market under study.

5. Exhibit #3 is a depiction of the AM and FM stations (commercial and non-commercial) providing service to the KGKL Radio Market boundary, a total of seven stations are shown, excluding any subject stations. Exhibit #4 is a tabulation of the stations in Radio Market #1 (KGKL/KGKL-FM/KELI/KNRX). A total of eleven stations are shown, including the four subject stations.³ The number of stations depicted falls in the fourteen or fewer stations tier of 73.3555(a)(1)(iv) of the Commission's rules. At this level, common ownership or control of up to five stations, with no more than three in the same service, is permissible, provided the number of stations to be commonly held does not exceed 50% of the stations in the market. Based on this number of facilities, it has been herein demonstrated that Market #1 is in compliance with the Commission's rules.

6. Exhibit #5 is a tabulation of the stations in Radio Market #2 (KGKL/KGKL-FM/KELI/KKCN); a total of eleven is shown, including the four subject stations.⁴ The number of stations in Market #2 also falls in the fourteen or fewer stations tier of 73.3555(a)(1)(iv) of the Commission's rules. At this level, common ownership or control of up to five stations, with no more than three in the same service, is permissible, provided the number of stations to be commonly held does not

exceed 50% of the stations in the market. Based on this number of facilities, it has been herein demonstrated that Market #2 is in compliance with the Commission's rules.

7. Based on the individual compliance shown in the rated and non-rated markets, the control of stations KGKL, KGKL-FM, KELI, KNRX and KKC� by Encore is in compliance with the Commission's rules. Therefore, the minor change/correction of coordinates application for KKC� is in compliance with the ownership rules.

8. The foregoing technical statement was prepared on behalf of Encore Broadcasting of San Angelo I Limited Partnership by Graham Brock, Inc., its Technical Consultants. All information contained herein is true and accurate to the best of our belief and knowledge. All data relating to AM and FM facilities in the relevant BIA/Arbitron market was determined using the BIA Financial Network, Inc. Media Access Pro, Version 4.0. BIA database. Technical data related to AM and FM facilities was extracted from the Commission's CDBS database. We assume no liability for errors or omissions in either database which may be adverse to the information contained herein.

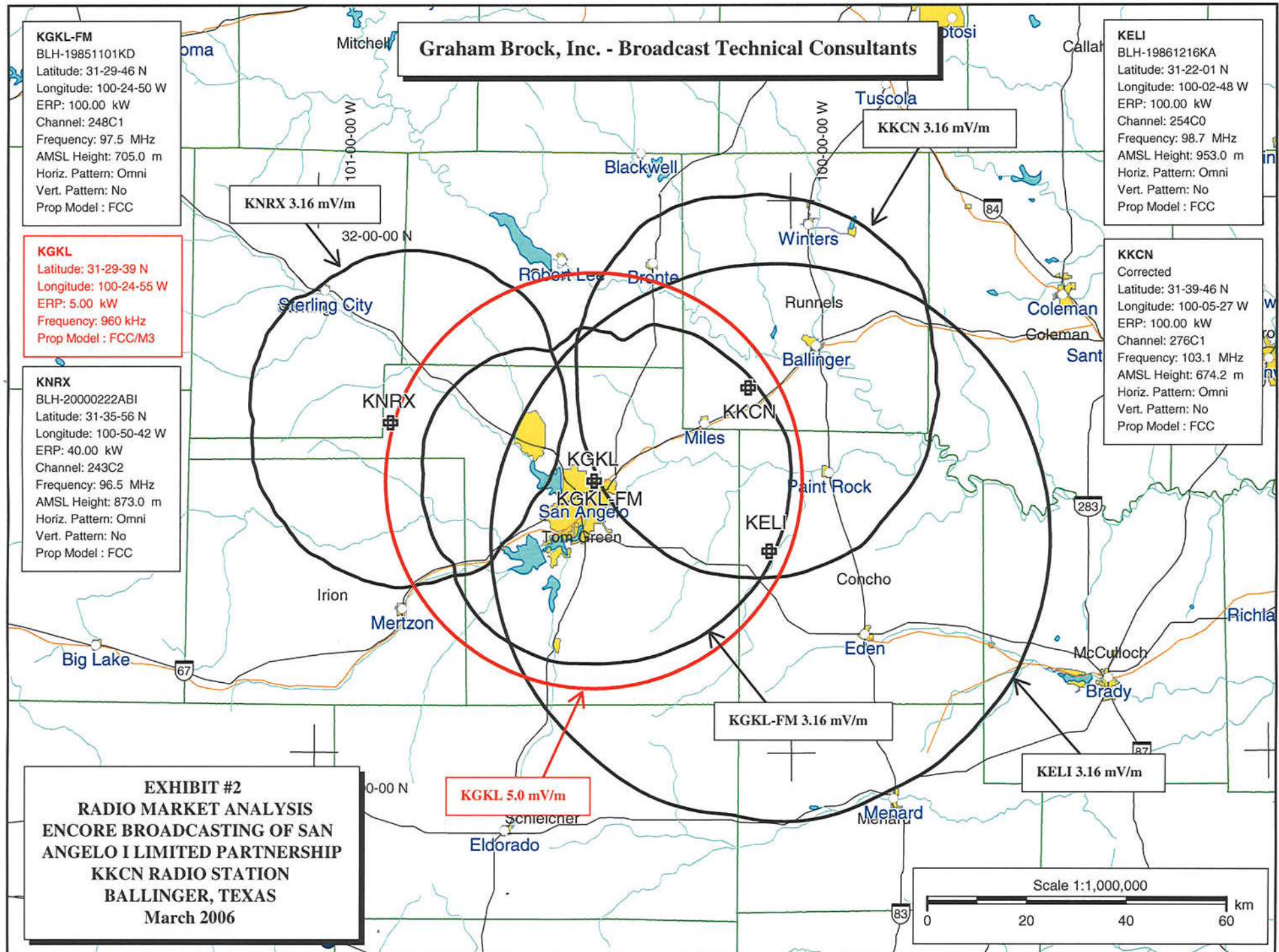

KGKL/Radio Market Boundary

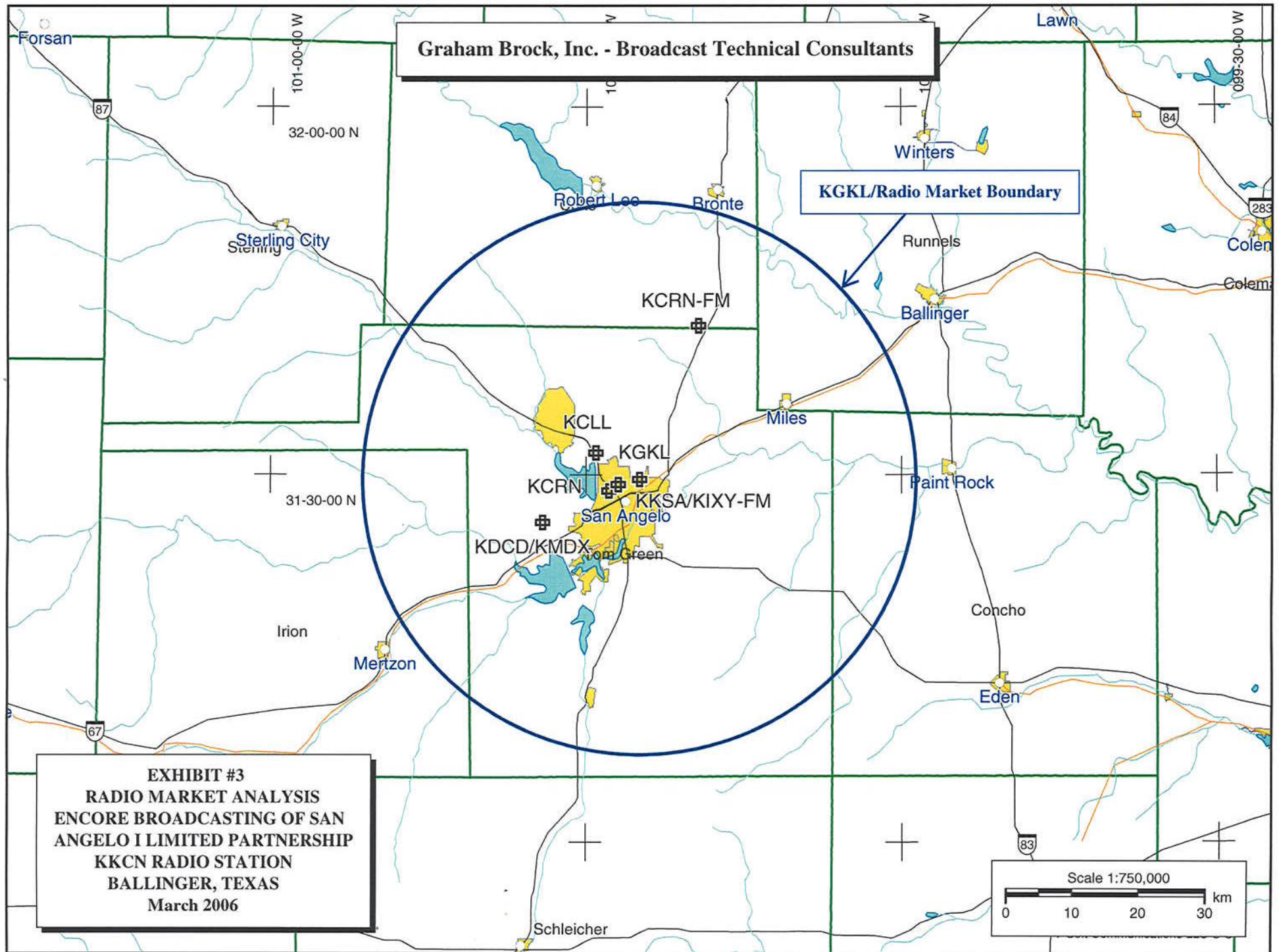


