

### **Response to Condition 3**

3 Warning signs which describe the radiofrequency electromagnetic field radiation hazard must be posted at appropriate intervals. Access must be restricted to prevent the exposure of humans to RF emissions in excess of the FCC guidelines (OET Bulletin 65, Edition 97-01, released August 1997). Permittee shall submit documentation of compliance with this special operating condition when filing FCC Form 350, application for license.

The door to the roof already had an EMR warning sign, and we added two more: One above the door so it can be seen if the door is open, and another near the antenna at the access point to the upper roof.

The calculated  $1 \text{ mW/cm}^2$  radius around the antenna is 2.57 meters (8.5 feet). This sign is more than 10 feet from the antenna, providing adequate warning for anyone who has access to the roof. Said access requires a key and is under the control of building management. Only trained personnel has a key.
