Nature and Educational Purpose of Applicant.Non-Profit And Educational Nature

It is the intent of the applicant to operate the proposed station in a manner consistent with Section 73.503 of the Commission's rules.

**The applicant is a Wyoming non-profit corporation which has received a determination from the district director of the Internal Revenue Service that it is exempt from federal taxation pursuant to Section 501c(3) of the internal revenue Code. Its qualifications as a noncommercial licensee are a matter of FCC record.**

Gospel Messengers intends to establish a full service broadcast station to serve and educate both the community of Cody, WY. And the communities within its coverage area. Gospel Messengers will broadcast a wide variety of informational and educational programming focused specifically on the needs of the audience. It will provide educational programs. (including home study courses of interest to the local college student and the general listening audience)

Programs of general interest for the listening audience will include local news events, senior citizens schedules, etc. News relating to safety, health, weather and general programs meeting the needs of the children and family type programs. Examples of programming are as follows:

Announcements of local events, interviews with prominent members of the Cody and other park county communities, active public service campaigns on a variety of topics and issues oriented talk/call-in shows focusing on the issues confronting both the local and the larger community. Periodic surveys within the community will be undertaken to ascertain the exact needs and desires of the community in terms of both entertainment and informational programming. In this fashion, the station will remain in the service of the Cody And the surrounding communities within its coverage area.

The station may broadcast programs produced by, or at the expense of, or furnished by persons other than Gospel messengers. But in these cases no consideration other than the furnishing of the program and the cost incidental to its production and and broadcast will be received bt Gospel messengers. The station will perform these activities as a non-profit and noncommercial service. No promotional announcements on behalf or for-profit entities will be broadcast at any time in exchange for the receipt in whole or in part of consideration to Gospel Messengers, its principals or the stations employees. The station may however acknowledge financial and other contributions made to the stations activities, but the scheduling of any such announcement or acknowledgement will not interrupt regular programming.
