SUPPLEMENT(Section III, Question 6, Exhibit 14)

On August 31, 2001, Journal Broadcast Corporation ("Journal") and Sawtooth Communications, Inc. ("Sawtooth") filed an application requesting Commission consent to the assignment of licenses for Station KIVI(TV), Nampa, Idaho, from Sawtooth to Journal (the "Application"). See File No.

BALCT-20010831AAU. As part of the Application, Journal certified that the proposed transaction complies with the Commission's rule regarding the common ownership of television and radio stations in the same area (the "Cross-Ownership Rule"). This supplement demonstrates the basis for this certification.

KIVI is located in the Boise Television Designated Market Area and the Boise radio metro market. Journal owns six radio stations in the Boise, Idaho, radio market. Assuming that KIVI's Grade A contour encompasses the community of license of each of these six radio stations, the Cross-Ownership Rule requires that the relevant market would have, as of the time the relevant assignment application was filed, at least 20 independent voices following the proposed transaction. The following table identifies at least 20 independent voices in the Boise Market as of the filing of the Application. (Radio stations in Boise, Caldwell, Garden City and Nampa, Idaho, are located in the Boise radio metro market. Other radio stations are included as a result of reportable share in 2001 Arbitron Spring Book.)

Accordingly, the Application complies with the Commission's Cross-Ownership Rule.
