Dear Mr. Forsythe:

This is in reference to the request filed on September 30, 2015. FBL requests a third extension of the STA granted on February 21, 2014, to operate station WNJC(AM) with emergency antenna facilities using tower #4 pursuant to Section 73.1680 due to vandalism.<sup>1</sup> In support of the request, FBL states that in the past six month STA period, additional repairs were made and all should be completed within a few weeks.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and station WNJC(AM) may continue to operate using an emergency ND antenna and reduced power not to



exceed 0.29 kW day and 0.043 kW night. It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. FBL must file an FCC Form 302 application to update all operating parameters due to all repairs done during STA operation.<sup>2</sup> FBL must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310. We anticipate that a new license will be granted before the expiration date shown below, otherwise FBL will most likely need to file a request to operate directionally with parameters at variance before that date (if the FCC Form 302 application remains pending).

This authority expires on **March 19, 2016**.
