

Request for Extension of Special Temporary Authorization

Susquehanna Radio Corp. (“SRC”), pursuant to Section 73.1635 of the FCC’s rules, respectfully requests that the initial special temporary authorization (“STA”) for radio station KTCT(AM), San Mateo, California (File No. BSTA-19990309WX, as extended, *inter alia*, by File No. BESTA-20080925AET), be extended for an additional 180 days.

The station’s most recent STA was granted by the Commission on June 10, 2009 and is scheduled to expire on December 10, 2009. In SRC’s June 9, 2005 STA extension request (File No. -20050609ADD), SRC noted that the STA was necessary to enable KTCT to overcome interference being caused by the unauthorized operation of co-channel station KXED, Mexicali, Baja California, Mexico. Specifically, KTCT was authorized to continue operating with its daytime facilities during nighttime hours in order to overcome interference from station KXED. The interference situation with respect to the co-channel Mexican station has not changed. Thus, the conditions which led the Commission to grant the initial STA (File No. BSTA-19990309WX), as subsequently extended and revised, remain the same. Accordingly, SRC respectfully submits that a further extension of the STA is warranted and hereby requests a further STA for a period of 180 days from the grant of this request.
