**TECHNICAL STATEMENT**

This Technical Statement was prepared on behalf of Oklahoma Community Television, LLC ("OCT"), licensee of low power television translator K68AU, Channel 68, Erick, Oklahoma. OCT holds an outstanding permit for K68AU (BDFCDTT-20091228AFE), authorizing a displacement to digital Channel 21.<sup>1</sup> This instant application seeks a license to cover the outstanding permit for K21JN-D. Attached as Exhibit A is a calculation of the transmitter output power for the K21JN-D transmitter.

There is one special operating condition or restriction on the K21JN-D construction permit. The condition states that the permit is subject to the condition that low power television is a secondary service and they must not cause interference to reception of existing or future full service television stations on either NTSC or DTV channel and must accept interference from such stations. OCT acknowledges this condition.

OCT will also, in cooperation with other tower users, reduce the power of K21JN-D or cease operation, as necessary, to insure that persons having access to the tower will not be exposed to radio frequency electromagnetic fields in excess of the FCC's guidelines. Based on the foregoing, it is believed K21JN-D is operating pursuant to the Commission's rules.
