


### Description of Involuntary Transfer of Control

This application is one of three applications being filed in connection with the involuntary transfer of control of Calkins Media, Inc. (“Calkins Media”) that occurred upon the death of Shirley C. Ellis. Use of FCC Form 316 is appropriate because control is being transferred to the co-executors of Ms. Ellis’s estate. Attached hereto is the court document appointing Stanley Ellis and Wesley Ellis as co-executors of Ms. Ellis’s estate.

Calkins Media is the indirect parent of WWSB License, LLC, the licensee of WWSB(DT), Sarasota, FL (FIN 61251), WTXL-TV License, LLC, the licensee of WTXL-TV, Tallahassee, FL (FIN 41065), and WAAY-TV License, LLC, the licensee of WAAY-TV, Huntsville, AL (FIN 57292). Calkins is a closely-held, family owned corporation, and controlled by three members of the Calkins family – Shirley Ellis, Sandra Hardy, and Carolyn Smith – each of whom has 33.33% of the votes of Calkins. In 2014, Carolyn Smith passed away and her 33.33% of the votes transferred to her estate. At the time of Ms. Smith’s death, no FCC approval was required to transfer the votes to Ms. Smith’s estate because not more than 50% of the votes in Calkins changed hands.

Now, with the passing of Ms. Ellis, the votes held by Ms. Ellis have transferred to her estate. As a result, there has now been a change in control of more than 50% of the votes of Calkins, requiring FCC approval.
