

**Exhibit E-9**

The construction permit for the facility as issued by the Commission contained three special operating conditions or restrictions. This exhibit demonstrates that the applicant would be in compliance with these special conditions.

The first condition required a partial proof of performance to be completed on the daytime antenna system for WMIX(AM) at Mount Vernon, Illinois. The antenna for WBMV(FM) is mounted on tower #1 of the daytime array for WMIX(AM). The required partial proof of performance was completed in accordance with the Commission's Rules. It should be noted that measurements prior to the WBMV(FM) construction were not performed; however, the measurements taken following the construction demonstrate the antenna has had no harmful effects on the WMIX(AM) antenna system.

Since a change in the monitor point limits and operating specifications for the WMIX(AM) daytime antenna system has been proposed, FCC form 302 for that facility is being filed with the Commission. A copy of the engineering portion of that filing is attached to this exhibit.

The second special condition requires the licensee to coordinate with other users of the site to ensure workers at the site are not exposed to harmful

levels of RF radiation. The applicant certifies that during the construction period such measures were undertaken. In addition, when future work at the site is warranted, the proponent will coordinate with all users of the site to ensure that workers having access to the site are not exposed to levels of radiation in excess of the applicable safety standards. It should also be noted that both towers in the array are adequately fenced to prevent casual exposure to the towers.

The third special operating condition or restriction pertains to the applicant's waiver of Section 73.1125 of the Commission's Rules. As indicated on the construction permit, the applicant was previously granted a waiver of this provision of the Commission's Rules to operate WBMV(FM) as a satellite station of WIBI(FM) at Carlinville, Illinois. The applicant requests that this waiver be continued.
