

Exhibit 1
Amendment

By this amendment, Local TV, LLC (“Local TV”), the proposed assignee, provides additional ownership information to supplement Exhibit 11 of this application. First, Local TV confirms that equity interests not set forth in the application are non-attributable. In particular, the application discloses all attributable parties to the proposed assignee's portion of the application, including all persons or entities that will have any material involvement in the management or operation of Local TV. All other such persons and entities are subject to insulation under the Commission’s policies pursuant to insulation provisions in the articles of incorporation of Local TV B-Corp A, Inc. and Local TV B-Corp B, Inc., and the operating agreement of OHCP MGP II, LLC.

Second, Local TV confirms that the proposed continuation of the common ownership of Oklahoma City television stations KFOR-TV and KAUT-TV complies with the Commission’s television duopoly rule, Section 73.3555(b). That rule provides, in pertinent part, that the same entity may own or control two television stations in the same market so long as: (i) at the time the application is filed, at least one of the stations is not ranked among the top four stations in audience rankings in the DMA; and (ii) at least 8 independently owned and operating full-power commercial and noncommercial educational television stations would remain in the market after the proposed acquisition.

KFOR-TV and KAUT-TV are assigned to the Oklahoma City DMA. In the most recent Nielsen ratings “sweeps” period of November 2006, KAUT-TV was not even among the top five ranked television station in the Oklahoma City DMA. In addition, following consummation of the transaction proposed herein, the television market would include the following television stations and owners:

The Oklahoma City television market therefore would continue to have 11 independently television owners. Consequently, the continued common ownership of KFOR-TV and KAUT-TV would comply with the Commission’s television duopoly rule.
