Dear Counsel:

On May 26, 2011, WMC License Subsidiary LL, a wholly-owned subsidiary of Raycom Media, Inc.<sup>1</sup> filed a petition for rulemaking to substitute channel 17 for channel 5 in the Post-Transition Table of DTV Allotments for station WMC-TV, Memphis, Tennessee. The proposal to substitute channel 17 at Memphis causes impermissible interference to the channel 17 and 18 repacked facilities assigned to WKMU, Murray, Kentucky,<sup>2</sup> WEPH, Tupelo, Mississippi,<sup>3</sup> and WVTJ-DV, Jonesboro, Arkansas<sup>4</sup> during the incentive auction and repacking process.

Accordingly, the above-referenced rulemaking petition IS HEREBY DISMISSED.
