Dear Applicant:

This is in reference to the request filed on June 26, 2017. HMG requests a second extension of the STA granted on June 7, 2016, to continue operating with reduced power due to recently installed power lines to allow time to file the required FCC Form 301 application to modify the licensed facility.<sup>1</sup> In support of the request, HMG states that it has been unable to resolve all problems caused by the nearby power lines over the past year, and now plans to file a minor change application to change from a DA to ND pattern at the licensed site.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and HMG may continue to operate with parameters at variance using reduced power to maintain all monitor points within licensed limits. HMG must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the



public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310. A reduced amount of time has been granted because HMG may need to change the STA parameters noted above after the application has been filed.

This authority expires on **December 27, 2018**.
