

PENDING APPLICATIONS — ALLEGATIONS OF CHARACTER ISSUES

Radio Station KRSH(FM), Middletown, California (FCC Facility ID No. 72925) has a long-pending License Application (FCC Form 302) (FCC File No. BLH-19931214KH) to cover a Construction Permit (BPH-199304) for the station. The permittee of KRSH is **INDEPENDENT BROADCASTING CORPORATION (“IBC”)**. Mary F. Constant, the sole shareholder, officer and director of **Grape Radio**, is also the sole shareholder, officer and director of IBC.

IBC inherited the KRSH Construction Permit and the license application from the former Construction Permit holder, **WINE COUNTRY RADIO (“WCR”)**, when IBC acquired the radio station in 1995 pursuant to BAPH-19950119GF. A challenge to the long outstanding license application was filed in 1997, and allegations were made by the petitioner, **SONOMA COUNTY RADIO BROADCASTERS ASSOCIATION**, that WCR (and its principals and agents) made false certifications in applications to the Commission.

Although the license application remains pending, the efficacy of underlying Construction Permit has been negated because — in an effort to resolve the issues raised respecting WCR’s Construction Permit and license application — IBC filed an application, and subsequently was granted a Construction Permit, to change the transmitter site for KRSH. That permit was granted on June 4, 1999 (FCC File No. BPH-19990329IF), and IBC intends to relocate the transmitter site.
