STATEMENT

This amended engineering report is submitted on behalf of Nassau Broadcasting II, L.L.C. ("Nassau") in support of a request by Nassau for assignment of radio station licenses from Big City Radio-NY, L.L.C. ("Big City") to Nassau. Nassau has been advised by the Commission staff that the acquisition of WWYY(FM) Belvidere, New Jersey results in the creation of two discrete markets rather than the single market originally proposed in the multiple ownership study. Therefore, the purpose of this amendment is to supplement the original multiple ownership study by providing an additional study for the second WWYY market. Although Nassau is the proposed assignee of four stations from Big City, only the assignment of WWYY to Nassau requires the submission of a multiple ownership study.

Nassau currently is the licensee of stations WODE-FM and WEEX(AM) Easton, Pennsylvania and stations WVPO(AM) and WSBG(FM) Stroudsburg, Pennsylvania. Nassau is also the licensee of AM station WILT Mount Pocono, Pennsylvania. The city grade service areas of WODE-FM, WEEX, WVPO, WSBG and WILT overlap the city grade service area of WWYY. In the original report, a map documented that the same entity

(directly or through affiliates) can own and/or operate all six stations and that a minimum of nine additional city grade services overlap the city grade service areas of the six Nassau stations in the market. However, the Commission has requested that WILT and WWYY be considered as a separate market. The original market study for the remaining five Nassau stations is still valid with the elimination of WILT, as there are nine additional stations shown, and only six are required to demonstrate compliance with Section 73.3555 (a)(1)(iv) of the rules.

A new study was conducted by the undersigned involving the separate market created by WWYY and WILT, which revealed that more than two or more additional qualifying services existed in this second market. In an abundance of caution, three qualifying stations are included in a mapping of the study results which is located in the rear section of this report. Stations that are or would be owned or operated by Nassau are identified with an asterisk. The stations identified on the map are:

- 1) WWYY 107.1 mhz 1.2 kw 219 m Belvidere, NJ*
- 2) WHCY 106.3 mhz 0.43 kw 262 m Blirstown, NJ
- 3) WKRF 107.9 mhz 0.84 kw 267 m Tobyhanna, PA
- 4) WILT 960 khz 1 kw DA Mount Pocono, PA.*
- 5) WARM 590 khz 5 kw DA Scranton, PA

The contours and procedures utilized to define city grade service in this report are identical to those employed by the Commission. For AM facilities, the required field strength is 5 mV/m and for FM stations, 3.16 mV/m.

CONCLUSION

Nassau's acquisition of WWYY(FM) would comply with the Commission's multiple ownership rules as they pertain to number of stations in a market in the two markets created by the acquisition of WWYY.
