

Multiple Ownership

This application proposes the acquisition by KASY-TV Licensee LLC (the “Assignee”) of three television stations: KASY-TV, Albuquerque, New Mexico; KWBQ(TV), Sante Fe, New Mexico; and KRWB-TV, Roswell, New Mexico. All are physically located within the Albuquerque-Sante Fe Designated Market Area (as determined by Nielsen Media Research).

The Grade B signals (and their digital equivalents) of KASY-TV and KWBQ(TV) overlap. The Grade B signals (and their digital equivalents) of KASY-TV and KWBQ(TV) do not overlap with those of KRWB-TV, Roswell. The stations are currently commonly owned, and the Assignee has no other attributable broadcast interests.

Section 73.3555(b) of the Commission’s Rules provides that an entity may own more than one television station in a DMA under one or more of the following conditions: (1) the Grade B contours of the stations do not overlap; or, (2) if there is overlap, (i) at least one of the stations is not ranked among the top four stations in the DMA in audience share, and (ii) at least 8 independently owned and operating, full-power commercial and noncommercial TV stations would remain in the DMA post-Closing.

As noted, the Grade B signal of KRWB-TV does not overlap with either those of KASY-TV or KWBQ-TV. Thus, the acquisition of KRWB-TV complies with Section 73.3555(B)(1) and does not implicate the multiple ownership rules.

While there is overlap between KASY-TV and KWBQ(TV), neither of those stations is among the top four stations in the Albuquerque-Sante Fe market in audience share, and at least 8 independently owned and operating, full-power commercial and noncommercial TV stations will remain in the Albuquerque-Sante Fe DMA following the closing of the proposed transaction. See Exhibit A. Therefore, the acquisition of KASY-TV and KWBQ(TV) complies with Section 73.3555(b)(2) and does not implicate the multiple ownership rules.

Thus, the assignment of this existing combination to the Assignee, who has no other ownership interests in the DMA, is fully compliant with the FCC’s multiple ownership rules.
