

Exhibit 15: Local Radio Ownership

As indicated in the attached BIA report, WRXW(FM)'s "home" market is Jackson, Mississippi. Including WRXW(FM), thirty-three (33) full-power radio stations are reported by BIA as being within the Jackson, Mississippi radio market. Under the Commission's rules, Urban Radio II, L.L.C. ("Urban Radio") may have a cognizable interest in up to seven (7) commercial full-power radio stations, not more than four (4) of which are in the same service, in a radio market with between 30 and 44 stations, such as Jackson.¹

Urban Radio would continue to be in compliance with the Commission's local radio ownership rules after an assignment of WRXW(FM)'s license to Urban Radio. Urban Radio currently has a cognizable interest three (3) full-power commercial AM radio stations² and three (3) full-power commercial FM radio stations³ that are reported by BIA to be within the Jackson, Mississippi market. Therefore, with the addition of WRXW(FM), Urban Radio will have a cognizable interest in a total of seven (7) full-power commercial radio stations in the Jackson, Mississippi market; four (4) in the FM service and three (3) in the AM service.

In addition, as demonstrated in the ownership narrative exhibit provided by Urban Radio as part of the instant application, Urban Radio has no cognizable ownership interests in any media of mass communications (full-power radio or television, cable television, satellite or newspaper) in, or near, the Jackson, Mississippi radio market.
