Request for Extension of Special Temporary
Authority to Remain Silent

Dear Mr. Oxenford:

This letter concerns the request you filed on August 10, 2015, on behalf of Gold Coast Broadcasting LLC ("GCB"), for extension of Special Temporary Authority ("STA") to permit AM Radio Station KKZZ to remain silent.

Commission records reflect that GCB stated that Station KKZZ(AM) went silent on January 21, 2015, for technical reasons. The previous STA was granted on February 12, 2015, and expired on August 11, 2015. GCB requests extension of its STA for continued technical reasons. The request includes the appropriate certification regarding Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.

GCB's request is granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit Station KKZZ(AM) to remain silent until January 21, 2016. **Notwithstanding the grant of this Special Temporary Authority, the broadcast license for Station KKZZ(AM) will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not resume by 12:01 a.m., January 22, 2016.**¹

GCB is required to notify the Commission when broadcast operations resume. If GCB does not file the notification of resumption of operations in a timely manner, the license may be subject to cancellation pursuant to Section 312(g) of the Communications Act, as amended.²

The station's silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for renewal of broadcast license. It is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's tower shall be maintained until removed.³
