This letter refers to the above-captioned minor modification application for K260CE.

An engineering study has revealed the application violates 47 C.F.R. § 74.1232(b). The applicant has not demonstrated the technical need for an additional translator serving substantially the same area as K279CI. Both K279CI (BMPFT-20160128BFM) and K260CE (this application) propose to rebroadcast KYKX(FM), Longview, Texas. The application fails to discuss this violation.

In light of the above, Application BMPFT-20160128BFT is unacceptable for filing pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 73.3566(a) and IS HEREBY DISMISSED. This action is taken pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 0.283.
