Modification of Construction Permit

WSWK – 1690 kHz 10/1 kW Unlimited
Avondale Estates, Georgia

It is proposed to change the city of license of WSWK from Adel, Georgia to Avondale Estates, Georgia. Avondale Estates is an incorporated city in Dekalb County, Georgia. Avondale Estates is within the Atlanta, Georgia Urbanized Area, but it is an independent community. Avondale Estates provides its own police protection. Fire protection is provided countywide by Dekalb County. Additional information about this community is attached to this modification application.

Adel currently receives aural service from WBIT 1470 kHz (lower band counterpart to WSWK), and WDDQ-FM 92.1 MHz. WSWK has a construction permit to locate on the WBIT/WDDQ site, but as of this date has not begun operation.

This proposal will leave Adel, a community of 5,307¹ persons with WDDQ-FM and WBIT-AM². If WBIT-AM ceases operation in favor of WSWK, Adel will continue to receive local fulltime service from WDDQ-FM.

The move of WSDK to Avondale Estates will again provide that community with its first local service. It should be noted that 1420 kHz, now WATB, Decatur, Georgia originally was licensed to Avondale Estates, but once this station changed its city of license to Decatur, Avondale Estates was left without local service. Avondale Estates has a population of 2,609 persons.

We have studied the total aural services providing primary service to Adel and found 8 AM and 6 FM stations providing primary service to that community (Exhibits #1A and 1B). We also have determined that no white or underserved areas will be created by the relocation of 1690 kHz (Exhibits #1C and 1D).

Avondale Estates receives primary service from 24 AM and 15 FM stations (Exhibit #2A and 2B). Also, there is no white or underserved area in this region.

¹ Population data is from the 2000 US Census.

² The applicant must decide whether or not to continue operation on 1470 kHz or 1690 kHz. The current WSWD construction permit expires in October 2003. Assuming continued operation on 1690, then WBIT-AM will discontinue its Adel operation.
