

EDUCATIONAL OBJECTIVES

The applicant is a non-profit educational corporation, established under Nevada Non-profit Corporation Law (NV Section 82.006). The governing documents of the corporation state it's educational purpose:

These are as stated in the charter, to wit: To obtain and hold broadcast licenses; to construct and to operate a non-commercial broadcast entity to provide quality, entertaining, and informative programming; to operate pursuant to the rules and regulations of the Federal Communication Commission; to provide suitable educational and cultural programs; to provide staff for operations under these purposes; to obtain and hold by deed or lease, real and personal property to be used in connection with the operation of broadcast stations; and to solicit and accept, in trust or otherwise, money and property to be used for these purposes. The corporation is organized and will be operated exclusively for charitable and educational purposes, and no part of its activity shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting in any manner to influence legislation. And that is a corporation, which does not contemplate pecuniary gain or profit, incidental or otherwise, to its members.

To carry out the aforesaid purposes, it shall be the policy of this corporation to engage in general and cultural communication activities; and to do all things necessary or appropriate to establish and maintain the highest quality non-commercial broadcasting service that may be authorized by the Federal Communication Commission.

ADVANCEMENT OF EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS

The proposed station will advance the educational program goals of Lucky Boy Educational Media, Inc. by providing a new program service to locations in Nevada, California, and the United States. Lucky Boy Educational Media, Inc.'s Mission Statement reads in part, that these stations will "provide a non-commercial broadcast with quality, entertaining, and informative programming".

As the licensee of a new non-commercial educational station, Lucky Boy Educational Media, Inc. will provide valuable educational programming and will strive to provide programming that will meet the needs of the local communities served by the station. The new station will provide a noncommercial educational program service, including various programming along with news and public information.
