ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

NONPROFIT CORPORATION

To the Honorable, the Judges of the said Court:

Be it known that the subscribers hereto, all of whom are citizens and residents of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, having associated themselves for the purpose of organizing INSPIRATION TIME, INC. under an Act entitled "Nonprofit Corporation Law", approved the 5th day of May, 1933, P.L. 289, and the amendments thereto, do hereby declare, set forth and certify that the following are the purposes, objects, articles and conditions of their association, and for and upon which they desire to be incorporated:

1. The name of the proposed corporation is INSPIRATION TIME, INC., which name was registered with the Department of State of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania October 22, 1964.

2. The location and post office address of its initial registered office in this Commonwealth is 3923 Crestmont Avenue, Erie, Erie County, Pennsylvania.

3. The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is to be formed are: To write, create, produce and perform religious, cultural and educational programs, and continuities for radio broadcasting; to enter into contracts with radio broadcasting stations for the production and transmission of religious, cultural and educational programs; to provide to the community Christian radio and Gospel broadcasting; in furtherance of the foregoing purposes, to acquire, equip, own, maintain and operate receiving, transmitting and broadcasting stations for the dissemination of news, reports, music, lectures, information and any and all other lawful purposes; to secure any



licenses necessary for such operation of a broadcasting station or stations; and to secure sponsors to help finance the cost of operation thereof, without personal profit to anyone by reason of being a stockholder thereof.

4. The term for which it is to exist is perpetual.

5. The name, place of residence and post office address of each of the incorporators is as follows:

6. The incorporators whose names and addresses are set forth in the Fifth Paragraph hereof are to act as Directors until the election of their successors.

7. The corporation shall have no capital stock; membership fees and dues of the members shall be assessed by the corporation as its By-Laws may determine. The fees and dues collected by the corporation shall be applied to promote the purposes for which the corporation is formed.

8. The complete control, operation, direction, supervision and policy of the corporation shall be determined by the Board of Directors, who shall adopt the By-Laws of the corporation and shall have the power by a majority vote thereof to amend the Articles of Incorporation in accordance with the law.

9. The number of Directors of the corporation and the term of office for which they shall be elected shall be determined by the By-Laws.

10. The corporation may acquire, hold, use and enjoy real estate and personal property as the purposes of the corporation may require, not exceeding the amount limited by law.
