The instant application proposes a change in the community of license of station WUSD(FM) from Geneva, Alabama to Hartford, Alabama. This proposed change constitutes a minor modification of the station's license pursuant to 47 C.F.R. 73.3573(g). The applicant hereunder, Gulf South Communications, Inc. ("Gulf South") is the proposed assignee of the WUSD license under the pending application in File BALH-20080718ANP. The consent of the station's current licensee to the filing of this application by Gulf South pursuant to 47 C.F.R. 73.3517(a) is attached hereto as Attachment A.

The change in community of license proposed hereby will result in a preferential arrangements of allotments under Section 307(b) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended. The proposed community of license, Hartford, currently has no local transmission service and WUSD would represent Hartford's first local service (priority 3; *see, Revision of FM Assignment Policies and Procedures*, 90 FCC 2d 88 (1992)). In addition, Geneva, WUSD's current community of license, would not be deprived of local service as it will continue to be served by WGEA(AM), Geneva, Alabama.

Because no change in the transmitter site or physical facilities of WUSD is proposed, the facilities at the proposed community of license will be identical to, and therefore mutually exclusive under 47 C.F.R. 73.207 with, those at the station's current community of license.


Hartford, Alabama, the proposed community of license, is an incorporated city in the southeastern portion of the state. Hartford has a population of 2,369 persons (2000 Census), and is governed by a Mayor and a City Council consisting of five members who serve four-year terms. Hartford has its own police and fire departments, and its own public library. Hartford also has its own post office and zip code. In addition, Hartford has numerous churches, including the Hartford Baptist Church, Sardis United Methodist Church, First United Methodist Church, Pondtown United Methodist Church, and Union Baptist Church. Hartford is also home to at least two banks, the First National Bank of Hartford and the City Bank of Hartford, and to a number of restaurants and other small businesses. The copies of webpages attached hereto as Attachment B provide further information regarding the foregoing. Hartford clearly meets the criteria that the Commission has used in the past to determine whether a proposed location constitutes a community for allotment purposes. *See, e.g., Kaycee and Basin, Wyoming*, 15 FCC Rcd 15767 (MB 2000).

Neither Geneva, the current community of license, nor Hartford, the proposed community of license, are within the Dothan, Alabama Urbanized Area, and station WUSD currently covers only .372% of the Dothan Urbanized Area with a 70 dBu contour. (See Attachment C hereto.) Since no change in the transmitter site or other transmission facilities of station WUSD is proposed, coverage will remain unchanged. Because Hartford is not within an Urbanized Area, and the station's 70 dBu contour will not cover over 50% of an Urbanized Area, a showing under *Faye and Richard Tuck*, 3 FCC Rcd 5374 (1988) should not be required. *See, e.g., Headland, Alabama and Chattahoochee, Florida*, 10 FCC Rcd 10352 (MB 1995).

STATEMENT OF LICENSEE PURSUANT TO 47 C.F.R. 73.3517(a)

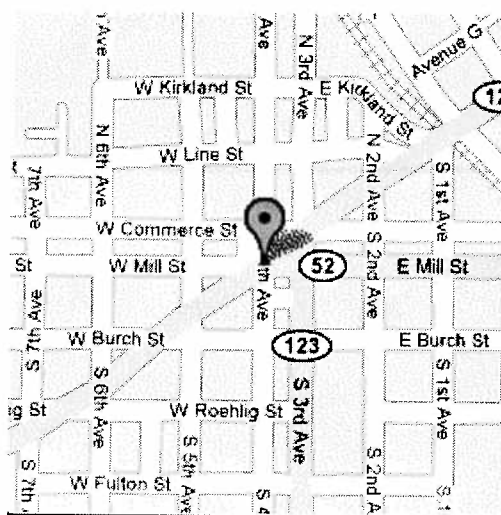

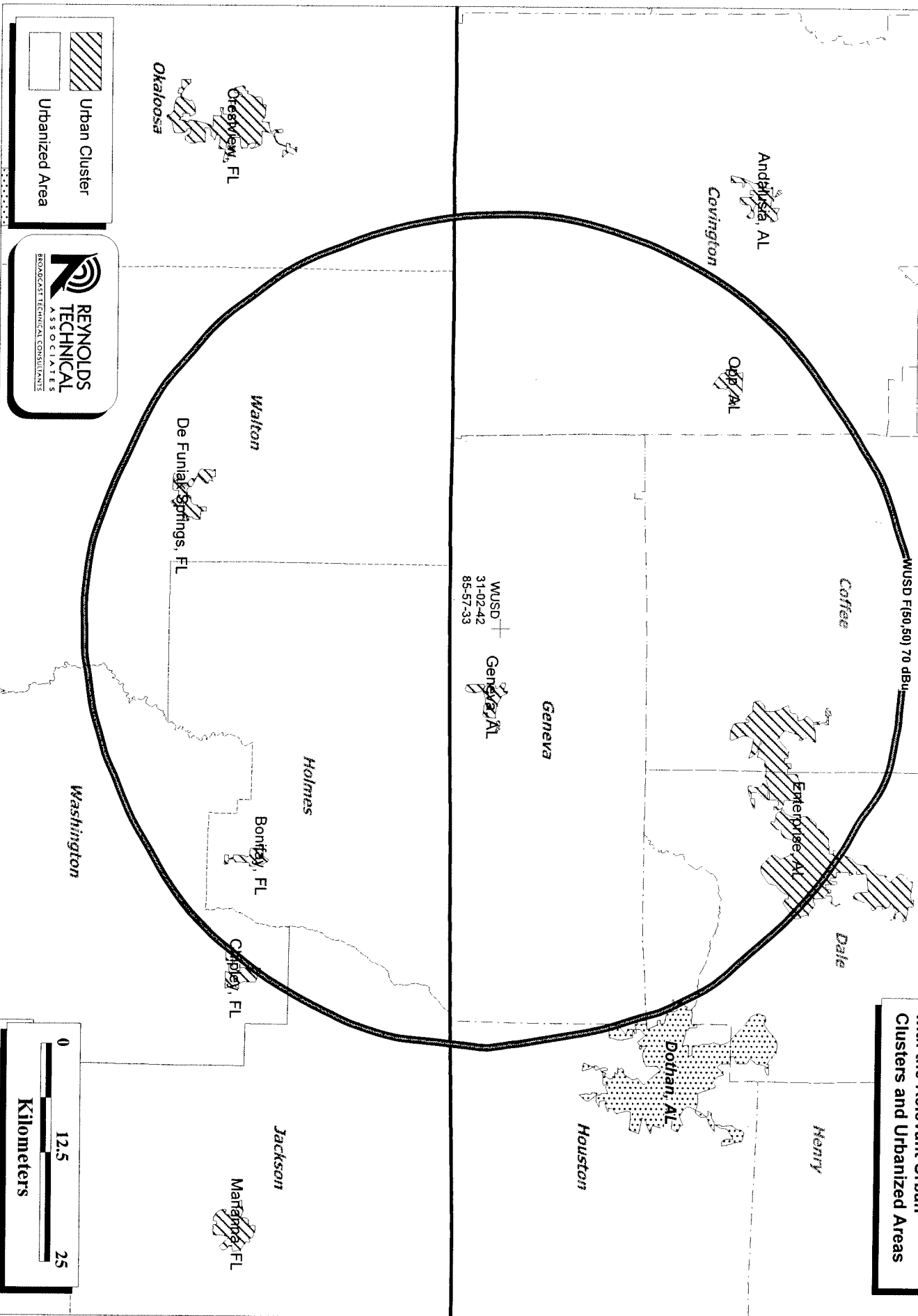
