

ENVIRONMENTAL STATEMENT

Redwood Empire Public Television, Inc., dba KEET-TV and the owners of other collocated tower have retained the services of Hammett & Edison, Inc., to evaluate exposure levels at the Barry Ridge Antenna Farm. The “Evaluation of Radio Frequency Exposure Conditions” is a living document and is updated as necessary.

The study was last updated on April 25, 2007 to include all transmission facilities, both authorized and constructed at the Barry Ridge Antenna Farm. At summary of the results of this study follows:

STUDY RESULTS – GROUND LEVEL

“Calculations indicate that existing and proposed exposure conditions comply with the public exposure limits at publicly accessible locations on all parcels at the site. The highest calculated power density in any publicly accessible area at ground level is 64% of the public limit.”

The above statement was taken directly from the report, which was prepared by Robert Weller, P.E.

Additionally, Redwood Empire Public Television, Inc., dba KEET-TV will continue to adhere to the power reduction schedules for work on the tower; therefore the site will also meet FCC-specified guidelines for limiting occupational exposure conditions.
