**TECHNICAL STATEMENT**

This Technical Statement was prepared on behalf of Nantucket Public Radio, Inc. ("Nantucket"), licensee of FM translator W230AW, Hyannis, Massachusetts. Nantucket has a construction permit to make minor changes in the W230AW facilities by changing location and increasing power. This instant application seeks a license to cover the outstanding construction permit (BPFT-20140320AEJ). Exhibit A is a calculation of the transmitter power output for W230AW.

There are two special operating conditions/restrictions listed on the W230AW permit.

The first condition states:

*"The permittee/licensee in coordination with other users of the site must reduce power or cease operation as necessary to protect persons having access to the site, tower or antenna from radiofrequency electromagnetic fields in excess of FCC guidelines."*

Nantucket states that it will, in cooperation with other tower users, reduce the power of W230AW or cease operation, as necessary, to insure that persons having access to the tower will not be exposed to radio frequency electromagnetic fields in excess of the FCC's guidelines.

The second condition states:

*"Prior to commencing program test operations, FM Translator or FM Booster permittee must have on file at the Commission, FCC Form 350, Application for an FM Translator or FM Booster Station License, pursuant to 47 C.F.R. Section 74.14."*

This application satisfies that condition.

Based on the foregoing, it is believed that Nantucket has complied with all conditions and can operate W230AW in accordance with Commission's rules.
