

STA NARRATIVE

The Licensee respectfully request approval of the emergency antenna site for station WMBH for a period of 180 days. The station had lost rights to the original station tower site and had applied for an STA. to go silent and find a new location. In the interim period, the current Licensee has found a site for a temporary long-wire system in Joplin to keep the facility on the air to serve the public.

Due to financial difficulties which ultimately led to the loss of the temporary site lease, the station was taken silent. The Licensee has now worked out a new arraignment with the transmitter site landlord to purchase land just a short distance south and will be able to use this tower site on a long-term basis. With the site issue resolved, the licensee is now determining if this temporary tower site would be suitable for permanent location. If it can be used, the licensee shall submit the requisite construction permit application to make the area close to the STA. its final location.
