Dear Ms. Nilon:

This is in reference to the request filed on August 10, 2015. FTR requests an extension of the STA originally granted in 1998 and last modified on July 18, 2014, to operate station WSRQ(AM) from an alternate site with temporary facilities due to loss of the licensed site.¹ In support of the request, FTR states that the new site lease has been finalized and it requested that BP-20150120AIX be granted to allow FTR to commence construction.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA is GRANTED, and station WSRQ(AM) may continue to operate with the following facilities:



Hours of operation	Daytime only
Operating power	0.15 kW
Antenna type	Vertical wire
Antenna efficiency	289.4 mV/m

¹ WSRQ(AM) is currently licensed for DA operation on 1220 kHz with 1 kW day and 0.159 kW night, and the pending application (BP-20150120AIX) proposes DA operation at the STA site using a 1 kW day and 0.004 kW night pattern.

It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. FTR must notify the Commission when licensed operation has been restored after an FCC Form 302 application has been filed and granted to cover BP-20150120AIX. FTR must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **March 15, 2016**.
