Dear Mr. Evertz:

This is in reference to the request filed on June 10, 2022. RVC requests a further extension of the STA granted on May 23, 2019, to continue operating daytime using the six tower nighttime pattern at reduced power to allow time to file the required FCC Form 302 application.<sup>1</sup> In support of the request, RVC stated that additional time will be needed to complete the remaining repairs to the three tower daytime pattern (and then file the application to update all operating parameters).

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.


Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and RVC may continue to operate with the licensed six tower nighttime pattern during daytime hours with a maximum reduced power of 30 kW, and with the licensed nighttime pattern during the night with 50 kW. RVC must reduce the daytime 30 kW power level further or cease operation if complaints of interference are received, and use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR §1.1310.

<sup>1</sup> KCKN(AM) is licensed for DA operation on 1020 kHz with 50 kW (day and night), using a three tower pattern daytime, and a six tower pattern at night.

This authority expires on **December 22, 2022.**
