Dear Sir or Madam:

On behalf of Townsquare License, LLC (“Townsquare”) (FRN 0030479497), licensee of the above-referenced station, pursuant to the Audio Division guidance issued on January 11, 2022 and January 25, 2022, we respectfully request special temporary authority for the station to operate at variance as described further below.

Due to significant wind damage to the antenna system cables and an above-ground cable support bridge at the transmitter site, the station has been operating with reduced power since February 18, 2022. Specifically, the station is operating at 80 percent of licensed power during the day. At night, the station is operating non-directionally and at 25 percent of licensed power. The station’s engineers are working to resolve the issue but repairs will likely take several weeks. In the interim, special temporary authority is respectfully requested. Townsquare will promptly notify the Commission when the station is able to resume licensed operations.

Undersigned counsel has been authorized by Townsquare to state that neither Townsquare nor any party to this application is subject to a denial of federal benefits pursuant to Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988, 21 U.S.C. § 862.
