

Attributable Interests and Multiple Ownership

Somerset Educational Broadcasting Foundation (“Somerset”) is a non-profit trust, directed by three trustees, all of whom are United States citizens. Somerset is the FCC licensee of the following noncommercial educational radio stations, all of which provide an important Christian broadcasting service:

WTHL-FM, Somerset, Kentucky; FCC Facility ID 60782
WSGP(FM), Glasgow, Kentucky; FCC Facility ID 91596
WVOG-FM, Cookeville, Tennessee; FCC Facility ID, 60780
WZWP(FM), West Union, Ohio; FCC Facility ID 74301
WGNH(FM), South Webster, Ohio; FCC Facility ID 61177
WNFC(FM), Paducah, Kentucky; FCC Facility ID 175623

A chart showing the current ownership structure of Somerset is attached. Somerset and its trustees have no attributable interests in any full power AM, FM or television broadcasting stations other than the radio stations listed above.

By this application, Somerset requests the Commission’s consent to assignment of the license of WPTJ(FM), Paris, Kentucky. According to Google Maps, the following are the approximate shortest driving distances between the community of Paris, Kentucky and each of the communities of license in which Somerset currently operates a radio station.

<u>Current Community of License</u>	<u>Distance to Paris, Kentucky</u>
Somerset, Kentucky	89 miles
Glasgow, Kentucky	150 miles
Cookeville, Tennessee	186 miles
West Union, Ohio	67 miles
South Webster, Ohio	117 miles

Accordingly, Somerset submits that grant and consummation of this application could not lead to any impermissible overlap of radio station service contours under Section 73.3555 of the Commission’s rules. In fact, grant of this application would promote the public interest by permitting Somerset to bring its valuable Christian broadcast programming to new listeners in a community that it does not currently serve.
