Dear Mr. Sutor:

This is in reference to the request filed on July 20, 2015. Entercom requests a further extension of the STA granted on June 17, 2011, to operate with parameters at variance and/or reduced power while maintaining monitor points within licensed limits due to repairs.¹ In support of the request, Entercom states that additional time is needed to allow for staff review of the pending application (BML-20170708ACL) to obtain a new license.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.


Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station WYRD may continue to operate with parameters at variance and/or reduced power while maintaining monitor points within licensed limits. It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease

operation if complaints of interference are received. Entercom will need to file a one page letter with the Secretary's office to the attention of supervisory engineer Son Nguyen to certify the station has resumed licensed operations per BML-20150708ACL (after that application has been found acceptable and granted).² Entercom must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commissions exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **November 12, 2015**.
