Dear Mr. Arnold:

This is in reference to the request filed on February 6, 2019. RAC requests an extension of the STA granted on February 12, 2016, to continue operating with parameters at variance due to the replacement of the original tower in 2013, the proposed sale of the licensed transmitter site, and the expiration of BP-20151005AAP on February 23, 2019.¹ In support of the request, RAC stated that it plans to file a new FCC Form 301 application after the sale of the licensed transmitter site in order to move forward towards the resumption of licensed operations.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or


¹ WMTN(AM) is licensed for ND operation on 1300 kHz with 5 kW day and 0.096 kW night, and BP-20151005AAP authorized a correction to the licensed site coordinates, efficiency, and tower height due to replacement of the original tower.

- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and RAC may continue to operate with parameters at variance and reduced power (if needed) using the replacement tower to allow time to file the new FCC Form 301 application. RAC must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See 47 CFR § 1.1310.*

This authority expires on **July 7, 2019.**
