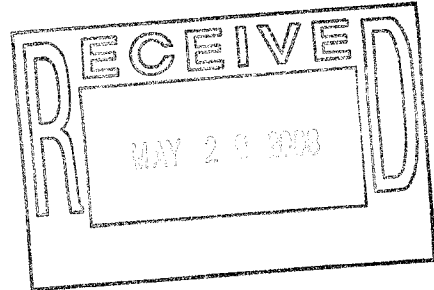

Dear Mr. Tannenwald:

This refers to the April 20, 2008, pleading you filed on behalf of WZBN TV, Inc.(WZBN), licensee of station Class A television station W25AW, Trenton, New Jersey, withdrawing the December 13, 2007, "Interference Complaint and Request for Immediate Order Requiring Cessation of Operation of DTS Transmitter" and requesting that it be dismissed with prejudice. You state that WZBN has reached a private settlement with the current licensee and proposed assignee of WTVE license pursuant to which those parties will finance delivery of the W25AW signal to a cable television head-end by optical fiber and will reimburse part of the legal and engineering expenses incurred by WZBN in this matter.

We have fully considered the matters set forth in the pleading and conclude that there are no substantial and material questions of fact that warrant further inquiry. Accordingly, your request IS GRANTED and the "Interference Complaint and Request for Immediate Order Requiring Cessation of Operation of DTS Transmitter" filed by WZBN TV, Inc., IS DISMISSED with prejudice.
