This refers to the above-captioned application for W283BO, Lancaster, Ohio.


Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 17.7, notification to the Federal Aviation Administration ("FAA") is required concerning the proposed antenna structure if there is any construction or alteration of a structure more than 61 meters (200 feet). The applicant proposes an overall tower height of 107 meters and an antenna height of 103 meters above ground.

Any proposed or existing antenna structure that is required to notify the FAA must register with the Commission prior to the proposed construction or alteration. FCC antenna structure registration may be accomplished electronically via the Internet at <http://www.fcc.gov/wtb/antenna/>. Please note that FAA approval is necessary in order to obtain FCC antenna structure registration.

By emails dated August 1, 2017, August 14, 2018 and September 28, 2018, the staff stated that WLOH Radio Company must register the tower with the FAA and apply for an Antenna Registration Number. Carl Gluck, WLOH Radio Company's consulting engineer, by email dated 8/15/2018, stated that the applicant is planning to move the proposed antenna to a different tower that does not require registration and the application will be filed within two weeks.

As of this date, the Commission has not received any response to the September 28, 2018 email or a received an amendment to the pending application. Accordingly, application BPFT-20170718ACZ IS HEREBY DISMISSED for failure to prosecute. This action is taken pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 0.283.
