

18 MONTH EXTENSION REQUEST FOR ELIGIBLE ENTITY

Pursuant to the rules promulgated by the *Diversity R&O*, “an eligible entity that acquires an issued and outstanding construction permit for a station...shall have the time remaining on the construction permit or eighteen months from the consummation of the assignment or transfer of control, whichever is longer, within which to complete construction and file an application for license.”¹

The permit for WJTJ will expire June 30, 2011. Therefore, upon consummation of the transaction, Alabama Christian Radio, Inc. requests an additional 18 months to construct the station.

Alabama Christian Radio, Inc., and all of its principals and members (that comprise the board), when summing the annual gross receipts along with the board member’s combined annual income, is an “eligible entity” as defined by Section 73.3598(a) of the FCC’s Rules.² Alabama Christian Radio, Inc. (and its boards annual gross income, in light of the aforementioned) qualifies as a small business entity under the Small Business Administration’s revenue standards for the radio broadcasting industry, which is no more than \$6.5 million in annual receipts.³ Alabama Christian Radio, Inc. grosses less than \$6.5 million annually.
