Dear Applicant:

On December 29, 2010, the licensee as addressed above was sent a 30 day deficiency letter outlining the following issues:

Our preliminary engineering analysis of the proposed facilities indicates that the site coordinates specified in the application is within the restricted geographic area as it was established by first-come first-serve public notice released on June 29, 2009 (DA-09-1487A1). Specifically, your proposed site is within 121 km of the following market(s):

1. Jacksonville, FL. Dist = 96.0 km

In addition, our preliminary engineering review reveals that your proposed facility does not comply with the Commission's interference rules. Specifically, the proposal is predicted to cause interference to the following facilities:

1. W63DB, Williston, FL. – BDISTTL-20071205ABG

You were given the opportunity to file a minor amendment to resolve the specified geographic restriction issue and the interference problem within (30) days from the date of this letter. Amendments must be filed electronically. If not so amended, your application will be considered incomplete and subsequently dismissed.

Our records show that no amendment has been filed as of February 10, 2011, to resolve the above referenced issue; therefore, the above referenced proposed application is considered incomplete and IS HEREBY DISMISSED.
