Audio Division Staff:

Ochoa Broadcasting Corp. (“Licensee”) licensee of WALO(AM), 1240 kHz, Humacao, PR (Facility ID No. 50011) (the “Station”), by its undersigned attorneys, hereby requests an extension of its existing Engineering Special Temporary Authority (“STA”) to operate the Station with increased power of five kilowatts during nighttime hours, which the Federal Communications Commission (“FCC”) most recently extended by BESTA-20220127AAB.

Licensee continues to receive interference from co-channel station HICV, Barahona, Dominican Republic (“HICV”), and operating with increased nighttime power is necessary to negate these effects. The Station has not received any complaints of interference regarding its nighttime operation but will reduce power if any are received. Accordingly, Licensee hereby respectfully requests an extension of its existing STA.

Licensee hereby certifies that neither it nor any party to this application is subject to denial of federal benefits pursuant to Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988, 21 U.S.C. § 862. Licensee also hereby certifies that the statements here are true, complete, and correct to the best of its knowledge and belief, and are made in good faith.
