TECHNICAL STATEMENT

This Technical Statement and attached exhibits were prepared on behalf of JMD, Inc., licensee of FM radio station WZNF, Channel 237C1, Lumberton, Mississippi. JMD, Inc., herein proposes to make minor changes in the facilities of WZNF by increasing power and upgrading from Class C1 to Class C0.

JMD, Inc., proposes to maintain their existing antenna. This tower has been registered with the FCC and assigned Antenna Structure Registration Number 1059698. Therefore, the Federal Aviation Administration has not been apprised of this proposal.

At the proposed/existing site for the upgrade, Channel 237C0 does not meet the Commission's minimum distance separation requirements to all licensed, proposed or applied for facilities. As such, a clear reference site has been designated, which meets the requirements of §73.207 and from which a 3.16 mV/m contour will be placed over the community of Lumberton and is suitable for tower construction as it is not located off-shore or on airport property (see Exhibit 2).

At the proposed/existing site for WZNF, on Channel 237C0, there is a shortspace to WDBT, Jackson, Mississippi. Therefore, processing pursuant to §73.215 is respectfully requested. See Exhibit A for details.

Since the WZNF antenna will be located on a tower with other FM and Television stations, the worksheets associated with Form 301 could not be used to demonstrate compliance with the Commission's radio frequency radiation limits. Therefore, a study was undertaken to show the proposed WZNF facilities are in compliance with the Commission's RFR rules (Exhibit B). All other documentation used to certify the technical portion of FCC Form 301 has been forwarded to the applicant and is available to the Commission upon request.
